- + Obtain practical experience related to health care in government or with an advocacy organization

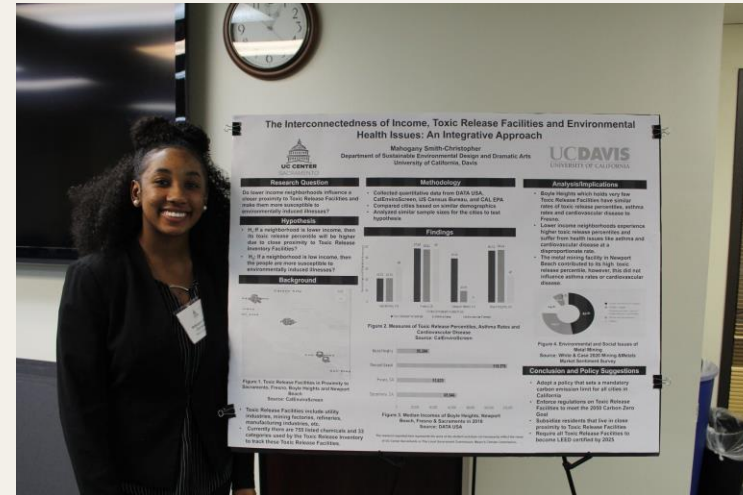
# Experiences Offered
